3. Purpose of the processing

eRisk is a tool used to combine operational risk and business continuity data with their business owners (users). For example to associate risks, action plans or incidents with

the users having reported the latter in the system. The tool contains staff data which are extracted from the ECB's staff management system and updated regularly. Operational risk incidents are reported by staff members via an automated workflow in the ECB Electronic Document and Records Management System (DARWIN) and then reviewed by a risk coordinator. Subsequently the information on reported incidents is exported to eRisk. Staff member details are then uploaded into eRisk for the purpose of following-up on the information recorded in the tool with persons having reported it.

- Personal details (name, contact details)

The information is retained for ten years from the point of inactivity in accordance with the of the ECB filing and retention plan.
