Status update (1/2)

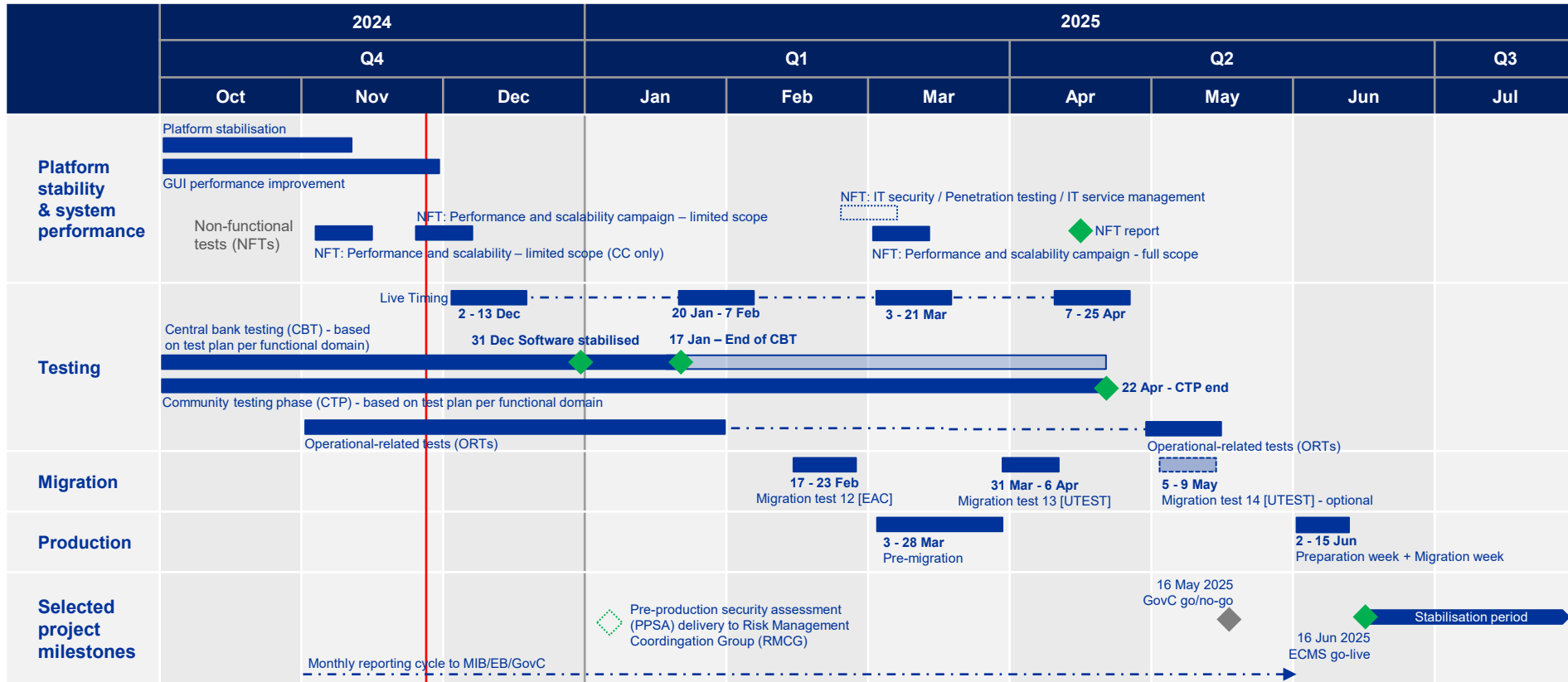
Following the ECB Governing Council decision (24/10/2024) for rescheduling ECMS to **16 June 2025**:

- Functional **User Testing (UT)** with CSDs/TPA and counterparties is moving into the final test phase, with functional testing to finish on 22 April 2025;
- MIB and the Governing Council are **closely monitoring** the status and the ECMS project (software quality and testing progress);
- **Migration testing** is continuously performed and has been building up gradually in terms of content and actors involved. The new final Migration test 13 will take place from 31 March to 6 April 2025, involving all actors (NCBs, CSDs/TPA and counterparties).

Status update (2/2)

- The go-live scope of the ECMS project will remain, in principle, frozen except for showstoppers → MIB approved one **change request on triparty** and one on **corporate actions** for inclusion in the go-live release to support community requests.
- Continued good **interaction with the communities** (CSDs, TPA and counterparties).
- **ECMS Focus session** took place on 20 November 2024 and some follow-ups are under discussion with the ECMS governance → For further information on the ECMS publications, please see the annex.
