
How ready is the market?



ECMS Community Readiness Framework overview

- Market readiness to go live is measured by a <u>set of milestones</u> as defined by ECMS governance.
- A successful big-bang migration is based on all actors, National Central Banks (NCBs), Closely
 Monitored Actors (CMAs) and Regularly Monitored Actors (RMAs) to be ready and follow the ECMS
 milestones.
- **CMAs** and **RMAs** are invited by their NCBs to provide as per a defined schedule information on:
 - A. Confidence level to go live in April 2024
 - B. Status of new milestones in the reporting cycle
 - C. Status of previous milestones in case they were still pending for completion in last reporting cycle
 - D. Confidence level to complete next reporting cycle milestones
- This information is then consolidated by the ECB and reported to the ECMS Steering Level (MIB), as priority after the CSLD go live



Status of Readiness

A. Overall confidence level – 9th readiness cycle (cut-off 16/01/2023)

- Response rate: both CMAs (98%) and RMAs (80%) have provided feedback.
- CMAs confidence level: 75%
 (48 out of 64) reported a green confidence level to be able to golive in April 2024.
- RMAs confidence level: 74%
 (967 out of 1307) reported a
 green confidence level to be able
 to go-live in April 2024.

CMAs and RMAs Confidence Level (CL)




Status of Readiness

B. CMA* % of new milestones due in reporting cycle completed

For the reporting cut-off of 16/01/2023, out of a total of **64 CMAs (17 CSDs, 1 TPA, 46 Counterparties)**

- 1 out of 18 have reported IAD8 (only applicable to CSD/TPA for this cycle) as completed.
- 18 out of 18 have reported NCOE1 (only applicable to CSD/TPA) as completed.
- 15 out of 18 have reported NCOE2 (only applicable to CSD/TPA) as completed.
- 32 out of 57 (not applicable to 7 CSDs) have reported IST1 as completed.



Status of Readiness Reasons for not meeting milestones – as expressed by CMAs

Key reasons for not meeting milestones so far:

- Insufficient resources/budget
- Dependencies with other internal and external projects (e.g., Migration to ISO20022; T2-T2S consolidation, T2S implementation)
- Impact on current internal procedures needs further assessment
- Dependency with SCoRe standards
- · Missing information or documents.

Actions taken to address the reported impediments:

- Operations related trainings fostering NCBs knowledge-base, to further train then their communities.
- NCBs organised training sessions for their communities.
- NCBs may organise additional national events.
- Regular and also ad-hoc workshops organized by Eurosystem for CSD/TPAs.
- Publication of reported missing documentation/information.

Intermediate Readiness Assessment

- In between the Community readiness reporting cycles (which can be quarterly or less frequent), regular NCB testing reports are produced, such as the ones related to start of testing phase and connectivity progress.
- These testing reports measure the NCBs, CSDs and counterparties readiness versus the readiness milestones NCOPP2* and UTAPP1**, to complete the connectivity testing and to start the migration testing activities in Pre-Production as planned.
