ASI procedure 6 real-time – Night-time procedure



Changes related to the procedure

- > T2 will still automatically open the night-time settlement procedure at 19:30 h (unchanged)
- It will not be possible for any AS using the ASI procedure 6 realtime to close the procedure, i.e. no daylight procedure with additional standing orders will be available any more
- ➤ T2 will <u>automatically close night-time settlement</u> at 18:00 h D+1without any intervention by the AS








ASI procedure 6 real-time – Business day overview

ASI procedure 6 real-time - Account



Currently: The mirror account used for prefunding can have a negative balance and therefore has to be owned by a Central Bank. As the mirror account can have a negative balance, all the payments from this account can be settled.

With ASI procedure 6 real-time it will be possible to assign the "technical account – procedure 6-real-time" either to a Central Bank or to an ancillary system. In both cases it will be possible to set the account as "credit-based only".

➤ If the account will be opened "credit based only", any debit instruction exceeding the payment capacity of the account will be immediately rejected with appropriate rejection code







ASI procedure 6 real-time – Cross AS settlement (I)



Currently: The execution of a "cross DVP settlement" between two AS presently requires the opening of a cycle by the sending system and the procedure 6 shall also be open for the receiving system.

Slide 27 of the presentation "ASI model 6 integrated"

- 1 INITIATION Request for Cross-DVP settlement:
 AS1 (or its CB on behalf) sends an XML message (ASTransferInitiation) with a single payment to transfer liquidity from the mirror account of AS1 on behalf of settlement bank A to the mirror account of AS2 in favour of settlement bank B.
- (2) FUNCTIONAL CONTROLS:

 If procedure 6 is open in AS1 and AS2 and if the cycle is open in AS1 then the order is transmitted to IARGE12 Payments module (PM), else the order is rejected.








ASI procedure 6 real-time – Cross AS settlement (II)



With AS procedure 6 real-time it will not be necessary anymore ...



However, the cycle-functionality will not be removed from the ASI procedure 6 real-time. If an AS opens a cycle it has to take into account that the liquidity is blocked until the cycle is closed again (i.e. no liquidity adjustment possible during open cycle)
