SSP RELEASE 14.0: START OF USER TESTING

The Eurosystem confirms the start of the User testing phase from Monday 14 September after the planned five weeks of Acceptance testing performed by the Central Banks.

In accordance with the [test calendar and test requirements](#) published on 15 July 2020, TARGET2 participants can start performing the recommended connectivity and interoperability testing, to be completed by 2 October 2020. Those Central Banks that organise Business day testing should complete them by 23 October 2020. TARGET2 participants and Ancillary systems impacted by the bug fixing must re-test the TARGET2 feature(s) and application accordingly.
