

- Involve in FX matters (reference rates, FX Global Code, interventions)


1. Conduct market intelligence and market analysis

3. Manage the ECB's foreign reserves


Foreign currency holdings


Foreign Reserve Management Decentralised Framework

- ECB's Statement of Commitment to the FX Global Code
- Adherence of FX Contact Group members and FX counterparties (<u>July 2017</u>
 <u>ECB press release</u>)
